## **ARISTEIA AWARDS**

Inaugurated in the 2004-2005 Season, the Playmakers! Theatre School ARISTEIA AWARDS acknowledge special contributions made by students leaving Playmakers! to pursue post-secondary education in any field. The amount of each scholarship will vary with the number of qualified award winners each season.

To qualify for an Aristeia Award a student must meet the following criteria:

- The student has participated in Playmakers! for at least 2 seasons, and continues to study or work with the school into the calendar year in which post-secondary education commences.
- The student has made an outstanding contribution onstage or backstage in at least four Playmakers! Theatre School Young Actors' Guild productions.
- The student has demonstrated exceptional commitment, creativity and a high degree of personal responsibility in fulfilling his/her obligations as a student of the school, and in modelling these qualities to other students.
- The student has played a significant role in the development of the school and its students outside of his/her own class. Activities as an In-Class Assistant, Stage Manager, Event Coordinator, member of the Board of Directors, or equivalent — carried out with a high degree of competence, dedication, and generosity of spirit — would meet this qualification.

Students who meet these qualifications and display these qualities are extraordinary and exceptional young people, and it is the pleasure of Playmakers! Theatre School, and our Artistic Director, Susan Kennedy, to acknowledge their achievements thus far, and to support their future development through the ARISTEIA AWARDS.
